As soon as we heard of the many students struggling to find a home in time for the start of the new semester, we decided to open the chapel (now mostly used as an event location) in the Schwesternhaus to 25 students as a place to spend the night during their first week at university. Since we don't have enough beds for everyone, we ask that you bring your own sleeping mat and sleeping bag.

As of now we are offering this option during the first weeks of the semester (27.09.19. to 28.10.19) only. We are asking for a fee of $5 \in$ per student/per night.

<u>If you are interested, just write an E-Mail or call (6 - 8 pm). You can register on site everyday</u> <u>from 7.30 pm to 8 pm.</u> You will be asked to fill out a registration form. <u>Registration outside of these</u> <u>times is unfortunately not possible</u>!

General Information:

Who is entitled to the emergency accommodation?	All students who have not yet found a place to stay in Hannover.
In which time frame is the emergency accommodation available?.	As of now we have limited this offer from, September. 27. until Oct. 28 2019. During this time we will decide whether or not to extend the offer.
Do I have to register?	If you are interested, just write an E-Mail or call (6 - <u>8 pm). You can register on site everyday from 7,30</u> <u>pm to 8 pm. You will be asked to fill out a</u> registration form. <u>Registration outside of these times is</u> <u>unfortunately not possible</u> !
How much does it cost?	5 Euro per person/per night
Where do I have to go and how do I get there?	Address see above. With tram 4, 5, 6 or 11 to 'Braunschweiger Platz'. Take the Hans-Böckler-Allee east until Schwesternhausstr. (on the right side). The Schwesternhaus is the big yellow house in the Schwesternhausstr. Use the entrance in the Kippstr. and go to the first floor to the chapel.
How many people can stay in the chapel?	We are able to accommodate 25 students. This allows approximately 4 m2 per student. Unfortunately we can only open one room, which means there is no separation between genders. We will do our best to accommodate special circumstances on site, but this is not guaranteed.

Guidelines to the emergency accommodation:

When does the accommodation open in the evening?	Due to other events in the chapel that have been previously booked, the opening hours vary. Sometimes you will need to wait (we have an extra common room), sometimes you could join, if you want.
How long can I stay in the morning?	You can stay until 8 am
Are beds, mattresses, pillows and blankets available?	Due to the small number of bed sets we have available we ask all guests to bring their own sleeping mat and sleeping bag (or similar). The floor is cold and hard!
Are there washrooms I can use?	Yes. There are three women's and three men's washrooms available to guests.
Are there showers I can use?	Unfortunately we can only open one shower to guests. Please shower in the evening.
Who is responsible for cleaning the chapel, the washrooms and the shower?	We are a self-organised student residence of which our guests are a part of during their stay. Therefore we require our guests to clean-up after themselves daily in all facilities (chapel, washroom, shower). This will be organised on site. If this does not work, we will be forced to end the emergency accommodation offer early, or raise the price.
Is there wifi available for me to use to look for an apartment?	Yes. At registration an internet contract can be signed, upon which you will receive internet access (there is no extra cost for internet use).
Is there a place to store my belongings during the day?	Yes. Personal belongings can be stored on the stage in the chapel. However, the chapel is locked from 8

	am until opening hours in the evening, and you will not have access during this time. Storage of personal belongings is at your own risk night and day, and we do not accept responsibility for any damaged or lost items.
Where can I stay during the day, when the chapel is closed?	A small common room (the Teestube) will be available to guests during the day.
Is there somewhere I can do my laundry?	Yes, please see following link: https://www.waschsalon.de/waschsalon-hannover/ #marienstrasse=94

General rules

Will I be kicked out if I do not follow the rules?	Please don't let it come to this! But yes, we reserve the right to deny anyone access to our house night and day, if their behaviour does not comply to our standards.
Can I smoke?	Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the house! However, there is a balcony for smokers. Gas stoves and open fires are also not permitted in the house!
Can I drink alcohol?	Please only consume alcohol as long as you are not disturbing anyone else.
Can I bring my dog or pet?	Out of respect to the other guests and the animals we are <u>not</u> allowing pets.
